

New York State Park Police PBA Scholarship



The New York State Park Police PBA will be awarding an annual college scholarship after the following guidelines have been fulfilled:

- The candidate must be a child of an active dues paying member, **(for 2 years)** of the NYS Park Police PBA and the candidate can only **receive** the award **once**.
- The candidate must attend college on a full time basis; minimum of 12 credits in the fall semester. The **application for the scholarship** is due to the scholarship committee **no later than December 1st** of their fall semester.
- Funds will be issued after the student completes the fall semester. A **minimum of a 3.0 GPA** must be maintained, and a copy of an **official transcript** must be submitted to the committee as proof that the requirements have been met. The **official transcript** must be received **no later than January 31st** of the spring semester.
- A maximum of six (6) \$250 scholarships will be awarded. If more than 6 applications are received that meet all of the requirements, the scholarships will be awarded by a lottery. If less than 6 applications are received that meet all of the requirements, the monetary value and number of scholarships awarded will be determined by the committee.
- The winner(s) will be notified by the scholarship committee. The announcement of the recipient(s) will be made at a NYSPPPBA meeting.
- Send the *completed form by December 1st* and a copy of an *official transcript* by January 31st to the following address:
